





Musculoskeletal conditions cost employers time and money

According to a 2017/18 report from the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) an estimated 6.6 million working days were lost to musculoskeletal conditions. They account for 24% of all new and long-standing absence due to work-related ill health.



Early intervention and funded treatments



We believe that earlier treatment usually means a shorter absence. The sooner an employer notifies us of an absence the sooner we can act.

For musculoskeletal absences, where appropriate, we arrange a referral to Physiomed, who will make contact within four working hours and treatment can start within five days. The Physiomed treatments are provided at no extra cost to the employer or employee. It also means employees can avoid NHS waiting lists or the cost of funding treatment themselves or claiming on a private medical insurance.


Every physiotherapist is handpicked by Physio Med. All physiotherapists need to have a minimum of four years' post-graduate experience in orthopaedics.
